Firstly, let me extend my genuine appreciation for our family community for embracing the challenges set before us in this unprecedented time in education. I have attempted to email you bulk information at select points rather than every few days. I hope you have found this useful. I do appreciate that managing learning at home and ensuring you support the 'check in' times have meant that there has been a volume of communication and we have been overwhelmed by how supportive and engaged you have all been.

The most recent information regarding the Prep and Year 1 return to school model from next week is also available on this site. The most pressing aspect of these changes remains the possibility of adult transmission and as such, we are following the protocol of limiting adult access to our site. Late arrivals will sign in at Admin and a staff member will escort your student to their classroom.

### Essential Workers:

### **Welcome to Term 2**

School life is certainly not what we are used to as we started Term 2 but we could not be more proud of how our students, staff and parents have been working in these unusual times to make schooling for your children as engaging as possible – both here at school and at home.

We cannot wait for everyone to be back at school and are looking forward to our Prep and Year 1 children returning to school next Monday, and our Years 2 – 6 students returning from Week 6. Keep up the great work and keep sharing your learning at home with your teachers – we love seeing your little video clips and photos, and keep being the best you can be.

### **Semester 1 Reporting**

Student Report Cards are a means to communicate information to parents, carers and students about student achievement each semester. Report Cards should include point-in-time information about:

- the learning expectations for the student;
- the student's achievement against expected standards;
- how well the student is engaging with the expected learning; and
- how the student may be able to improve.

In light of the unusual circumstances to start 2020, the Education Department has provided schools with guidelines for Semester 1 Reporting to Parents. Reporting for all students this semester will therefore be adjusted to reflect the modified nature of learning that occurred during Term 2 and the subjects to be reported on for Semester 1 have been adjusted accordingly for BPSS.

For Prep, a description of learning will be provided for English, mathematics, science and HASS only, based on the teaching in Term 1 and Term 2, through both home-based and school face-to-face learning.

**Prep students will receive grades on their Semester Two report card.**

From Year 1 to Year 6, report card levels of achievement will be provided for English, mathematics, science and HASS only. The evidence used to determine these grades will be based on a combination of teaching and assessment in Term 1 and Term 2, home-based and school face-to-face learning.

**All Semester 1 Report Cards will be emailed home early Term 3.**

### **Parent Teacher Interviews**

Usually, following our Semester 1 Reports, we would plan for our second round of Parent Teacher interviews to occur partway through Term 3. The current situation may also affect our ability to conduct Parent Teacher interviews in Term 3; we will await further direction from the Government and keep our families updated accordingly.

Parents, we trust the emailed information our teachers forwarded home late Term 1 provided you with sufficient information as we move towards our revised Reporting format. You are very welcome to make contact with your child's teacher at any time prior to reporting, if you have any specific concerns leading up to our first reporting period for 2020.

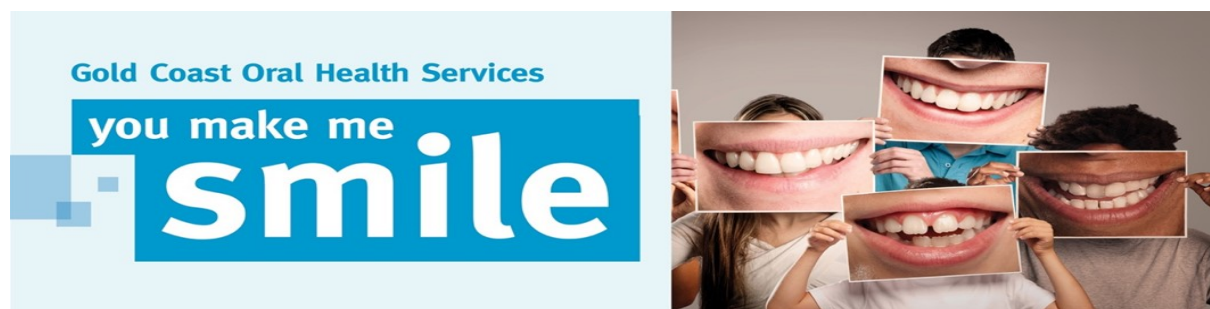
