Improve student achievement in Mathematics, Reading and Writing, resulting in:

- An increase from 2018 of Year 3 and Year 5 students achieving within the upper two bands of NAPLAN testing in Reading and Numeracy.
- An increase from 2018 results of students in Year 3 and Year 5 meeting the National Minimal Standard in NAPLAN across all domains.
- An increased percentage of students meeting or exceeding year level targets in English and Mathematics.

Our initiatives include

Improving pedagogy

- Providing high quality, needs-based professional development that aligns with the Annual Implementation Plan.
- Continuing school-based professional roles to build teacher capability in the planning, instruction and assessment of reading, writing and Mathematics.

Building collaborative structures that enhance professional curriculum knowledge and delivery

- Supporting the release of Professional Learning Teams to collaboratively plan and prioritise curriculum to ensure critical content is covered across P-6.
- Releasing Professional Learning Teams to work within the cycle of inquiry and assess their impact of teaching a Guaranteed and Viable Curriculum.

Delivery targeted intervention and extension

- Embedding of Response to Intervention processes school-wide, to ensure timely and targeted support, consolidation and extension for students across P-6.
- Additional learning support teacher and teacher-aide assistance in prioritised learning areas.
