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# Bellevue Park The Arts P - 2 Program



## P – 2 MUSIC PROGRAM



### Prep

The focus is to develop students' ability in the musical elements of beat, rhythm and dynamics. Students demonstrate their learning by improvising, staying in tune and keeping in time when singing familiar songs and playing instruments.

### Year 1

The focus is to develop students' ability in the musical elements of rhythm, pitch, dynamics, timbre and tempo. Students demonstrate their learning by recognising and composing short rhythmic patterns and staying in tune when singing.

### Year 2

The focus is to develop students' ability in the musical elements of rhythm, pitch, dynamics, form, structure, timbre and texture. Students demonstrate their learning by composing and performing rhythmic patterns on the glockenspiel, keeping in time when singing and playing instruments and reflecting on their music making ability.

## P – 2 DANCE PROGRAM

### Prep

The focus was is to develop students' ability to learn the elements of dance using safe practices. Students demonstrate their learning by remembering and performing their class dance.

### Year 1

The focus is to develop students' ability to learn dance combinations. Students demonstrate their learning by performing their class dance and reflecting through discussion.

### Year 2

The focus was to develop students' ability to learn dance combinations using timing. Students demonstrate their learning by performing their class dance and reflecting through discussion.

## P – 2 DRAMA PROGRAM

### Prep

The focus is to develop students' understanding of role and character when making, performing and viewing drama. Students demonstrate their learning by participating in dramatic play.

### Year 1

The focus is to develop students' understanding of role and character when making, performing and viewing drama. Students demonstrate their learning by creating characters to communicate ideas.

### Year 2

The focus is to develop students' understanding of role, character and focus when making, performing and viewing drama. Students demonstrate their learning by making, performing and responding through drama to communicate ideas.
